

apply for the Illinois Child Care Assistance Program in 4 easy steps



The Illinois Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) provides low-income, working families with access to quality, affordable child care that allows them to continue working and contributes to the healthy, emotional and social development of the child. Families are required to cost-share on a sliding scale based on family size, income, and number of children in care.

Determine your eligibility for the Illinois Child Care Assistance Program.

You may be eligible if:
1—your children are under the age of 13

2— you are working or enrolled in an approved education or training program

3—your family's monthly gross income is less than:

- \$2,151 for a family of 2
- \$2,713 for a family of 3
- \$3,274 for a family of 4
- \$3,836 for a family of 5
